*Benediction* explores the turbulent life and times of First World War poet Siegfried Sassoon, through the eyes of the revered filmmaker Terence Davies. Decorated for his bravery, Sassoon was a complex man who became a vocal critic of the government's continuation of the war when he returned from service. His story is one of a troubled man in a fractured world searching for peace and self-acceptance, something which speaks as meaningfully to the modern world now as it did then.

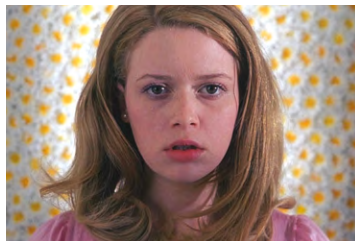
