# Welcome

The Film Festival has passed for another year. I'm probably in a remote corner of the building somewhere, rocking back and forth slowly and wondering how I'm going to manage to do this all again next year.

Dear Reader, I'm not. The reason I'm not is that this programme starts with two of the best films of the year. Ken Loach's new film Sorry We Missed You - about zero hour contracts, the gig economy and a young family struggling to get by. It's another vital film from the master of social realism, and a must see in the lead up to yet another general election. Monos was the winner of the Best Film at the London Film Festival in October. Set mainly on a remote Colombian mountaintop, a group of young soldiers are looking after a kidnapped American. It's the most beautifully shot film of the year, it's a hallucinogenic experience at times, and features a stunning score by the British composer Mica Levi (which I'm listening to as I write this in a very noisy office, she also composed the scores for Under the Skin and Jackie).

If you're not too filmed out by the Inverness Film Festival we are screening films from the Take One Action Film Festival, French Film Festival, UK Jewish Film Festival and the BFI Musicals tour.

Perhaps you're looking for something different, something a little out of the ordinary. Well, if that's the case we have you covered. First up is the continuing adventures of Elsa and Anna in Frozen 2, then Matt Damon and Christian Bale join forces with Ford in Le Mans '66 to give those pesky European racing giants Ferrari a race for their money, after that Daniel Craig leads an all star cast in *Knives Out;* a clever and funny mansion murder mystery. Lastly, well it's Episode 9 and probably the last one in the saga, is Star Wars: The Rise of Skywalker - I've loved the last few Star Wars films, Daisy Ridley has breathed a breath of fresh air into the franchise after the prequels, and I can't wait for the midnight screening to find out what happens.

I hope you enjoy what you see and please do let me know what you think.


