Writer-director Greta Gerwig follows up her Oscar-nominated debut *Lady Bird* with an adaptation of *Little Women* that draws on both the classic novel and the writings of Louisa May Alcott. In Gerwig's take, the beloved story of the March sisters - four young women each determined to live life on her own terms - is both timeless and timely.

Portraying Jo, Meg, Amy, and Beth March, the film stars Saoirse Ronan, Emma Watson, Florence Pugh, Eliza Scanlen, with Timothée Chalamet as their neighbour Laurie, Laura Dern as Marmee, and Meryl Streep as Aunt March.

## RPS Members Exhibition

JANUARY | STALLS GALLERY

Scottish members of The Royal Photographic Society submit images each year towards an exhibition to show the variety and quality of their work. The selection process involves members across Scotland in a sometimes fierce but always good-natured debate, with the submitted prints reduced through discussion to the 40 images in the final exhibition.

Immediately after selection, the exhibition is catalogued, and starts a 12-month tour to 8 venues between Inverness in the North and the Borders in the South.

## Nigel Sandeman Taxonomy of Demons

JANUARY | 1ST CIRCLE GALLERY

Inverness artist Nigel Sandeman uses his work to explore issues of male mental health and attitudes towards the concept of masculinity. Borne out of his experiences living with a lifelong mental health condition, Nigel uses art to exorcise his own personal demons.
